## FEATURES OF KNOWLEDGE ECONOMY FORMATION IN MODERN CONDITIONS

## ABSTRACT

Knowledge economy is the latest stage of institutional evolution of capitalism, that based on the growing of the business processes in the post-industrial world.

The basis for the formation of knowledge economy is two driving forces: the intensity of use of knowledge in business and globalization of economic relations.
